Young Scientist Presentation Prizes

Participants selected for oral communications will be entered into the oral presentation competition which will be judged at the workshop. To be eligible to win the poster prize, you must submit a PDF of your poster by March 13th 2017.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

1.	Abstracts must be submitted by e-mail to sabine.langie@vito.be
2.	Each participant submitting an abstract is required to register for the workshop before 6 th March 2017.
3.	All abstracts must be submitted and presented in English .
4.	Please prepare your abstract(s) as a separate Word file (.doc) using the following format (see sample abstract): <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Spacing: single● Margins: top: 2.5 cm; bottom 2.5 cm; left: 2.5 cm; right: 2.5 cm● Font: Times New Roman● Font size: 12 pt■ The abstract should contain the title in bold.■ After one empty line the name(s) of the author(s) [e.g. Volker M. Arlt¹ and Jill McKay²]■ After one empty line the affiliation(s) of the author(s) [e.g. ¹King's College London, London, UK] in italic.■ After one empty line the abstract body should follow (no subheadings), stating clearly the purpose of the study, methods, results and conclusions. Do not use phrases such as 'data will be presented' or 'results will be discussed'.■ Abstract text including references should not exceed 300 words.
5.	All abstracts will be reviewed upon receipt. Submitted abstracts that do not adhere to the requested abstract style will be returned for revision .
6.	The acceptance of your abstract will be confirmed by e-mail.
	Note: All accepted abstracts will be published online in <i>Mutagenesis</i> .
